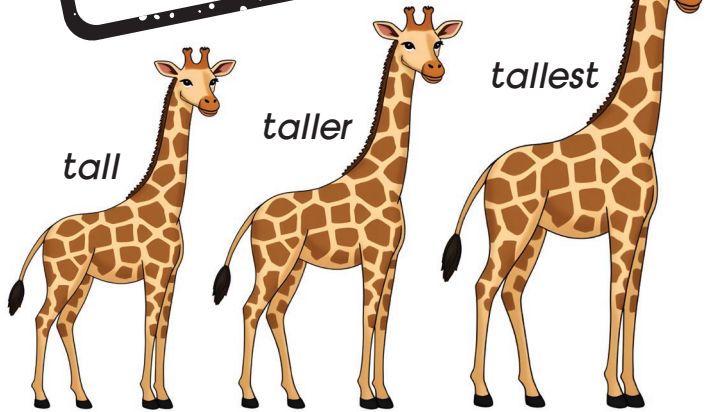


Let's COMPARE

Sometimes we need to compare things. For example, we might see a tall tree, but there is a tree that is taller and then the next one is the tallest!

We add 'er' or 'est' to the word tall.



This is called DEGREES OF COMPARISON.



Sometimes you cannot add 'er' or 'est' to the word, we have to add 'more' or 'most'.
