The American Civil War was mainly fought over slavery.

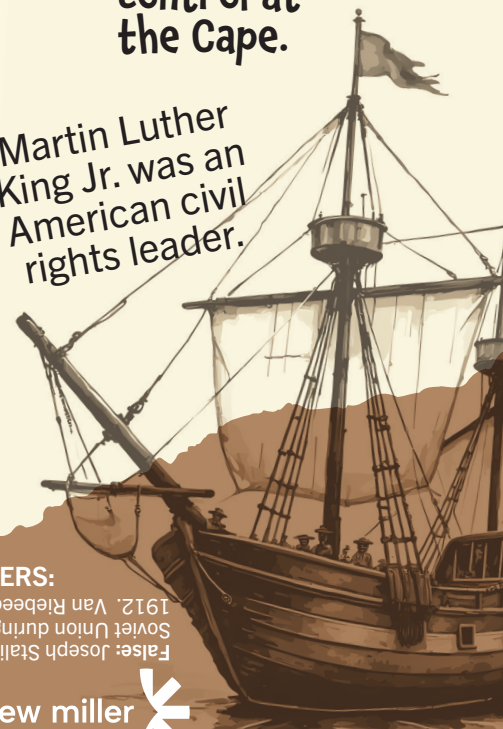
Martin Luther King Jr. was an American civil rights leader.
