

# SAY IT IN COLOUR!

DID YOU KNOW THAT COLOURS CAN SPEAK? Well, not really - but in English, we use lots of fun expressions with colours to describe feelings, situations, and surprises!

Let's explore some colourful idioms and find out what they really mean.

I'm tickled PINK!

## PINK

### TICKLED PINK

*Very happy or pleased.*

e.g.: She was tickled pink with her birthday present.

## BLUE

### ONCE IN A BLUE MOON

*Something that happens very rarely.*

e.g.: We go on holiday once in a blue moon.

### OUT OF THE BLUE

*Something that happens unexpectedly.*

e.g.: Out of the blue, he arrived at my house.

## WHITE

### A WHITE LIE

*A small lie told to avoid hurting someone.*

e.g.: She told a white lie about liking her friend's new hairstyle.

## RED

### SEE RED

*To become very angry.*

e.g.: He saw red when someone broke his toy.

### CAUGHT RED-HANDED

*Caught in the act of doing something wrong or naughty.*

e.g.: He was caught red-handed taking a cookie before dinner.

I'm seeing RED!

I'm GREEN with envy!

## GREEN

### GREEN WITH ENVY

*Feeling very jealous.*

e.g.: He was green with envy when he saw his friend's new bike.
